The third segment of The Thread along Broad Street is now open to the public. Construction continues on the extension of Phase 3 through the LaGrange College campus, connecting The Thread from Vernon Road to the LaGrange College Baseball Field. This portion has been partially funded by a Recreational Trails Program grant.

Simultaneously, The Thread will also be extended out onto Country Club Road. Both segments are expected to be complete by Summer 2019.
