## **LaGrange Fire Department Responds to Structure Fire at 502 Milam Street**

*LaGrange, Ga. November 4, 2020* – The LaGrange Fire Department was dispatched on Tuesday November 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9:25 p.m. to 502 Milam Street for the report of a structure fire.



LFD responded to a fire on Milam Street

The first unit that arrived on the scene advised nothing showing from the alpha side of the residence. After command and accountability was established, crews located the fire through the window from the bravo side. Fire crews advanced a 1 ¾ attack line through the front door and

into the kitchen where they quickly extinguished the fire. The fire damage was contained to the kitchen. The fire was under control and extinguished at 9:34 p.m.

No one was at home at the time of the fire. There were no reported injuries.

Fire damage is estimated to be \$2,000.

The cause of the fire was determined to be electrical.
