City of LaGrange Provides Update of Country Club Road Improvements

LaGrange, Ga. August 17, 2018 – The City of LaGrange is providing an update on the Country Club Road improvements.

Letters from the City will be mailed to area residents and property owners next week.

The City is almost finished patching the road where it settled unevenly due to a previous sewer infrastructure project.

Upon completion of those repairs, the City will begin resurfacing the road from the roundabout to County Club Drive and adding The Thread Trail.

“The City is approaching the pending project holistically,” said City of LaGrange Senior Planner Leigh Threadgill.

“We are taking into consideration other planned changes that can be accommodated as part of the resurfacing.”

The Thread has been planned to run along much of this section of County Club Road. In order to build the trail, there are some necessary changes to the road cross-section.

The existing curb line along the east side of the road will shift approximately 12 feet to the west. The crown of the road will also shift west to provide for proper drainage.

Once the project is completed, Country Club Road will be repaved and striped without bike lanes and a new header curb will be added and The Thread will be built.
