

## Curbside Recycling Rules

Recycling cans will be emptied according to your regular garbage pickup schedule. Recyclables will be collected every other week on the same schedule day as your garbage beginning February 1, 2016.

**ATTENTION ALL RECYCLING CANS MUST BE ON THE CURB BEFORE 7AM ON YOUR COLLECTION DAY.**

**NOTE: WE DO NOT OFFER ANY BACK DOOR SERVICE FOR RECYCLING!**

Please keep lid closed. No contaminated recyclables will be accepted.

Contaminated items will be collected as garbage. No garbage of any kind will be allowed in the recycling container.

**No glass of any kind will be allowed in the recycling container.**

All boxes are required to be broken down and Styrofoam and packing materials removed. Any cardboard or newspapers too large for the recycling container should be neatly stacked beside the can and tied up if possible. **All cardboard boxes must be broken down and stacked neatly. Any boxes that are not broken down will be considered trash.**

All tin and aluminum cans should be rinsed, cleaned, and drained. **No food or liquid residue is allowed. Residue in cans will be considered contaminated and collected as garbage. Bagging of tin and aluminum is permitted.**

All plastic bottles, containers, and jugs should be rinsed, cleaned, and drained. No food or liquid residue is allowed. Residue in the plastic containers will be considered contaminated and collected as garbage. We will accept plastic bottles (numbered 1 through 7). The number can be found on the bottom of the plastic container.



**Bagging of plastic is permitted.**

All newspapers and magazines should be clean and dry and placed in the container or bundled and tied and placed beside the container.

The City will make the determination whether the recyclables are contaminated or not. Contaminated cans will be left until the next recycle collection week. If the recycle container is not corrected by the next week it will be emptied as garbage. If contamination continues to be an issue with your recycling container the City may cancel your recycling collection and pick up your container.
